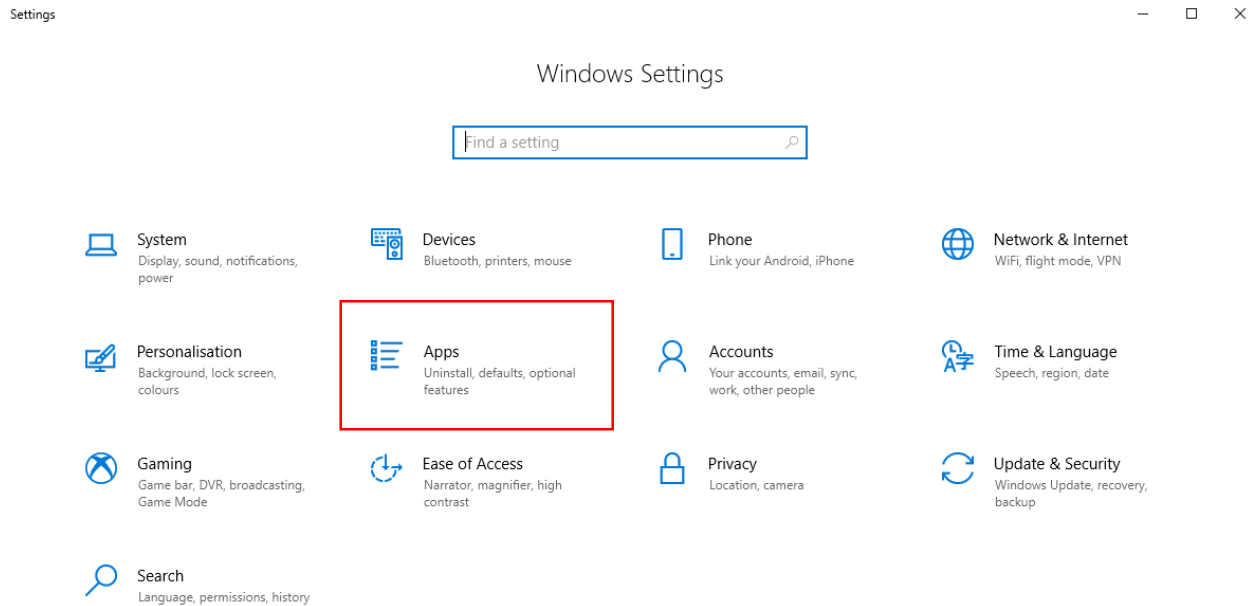




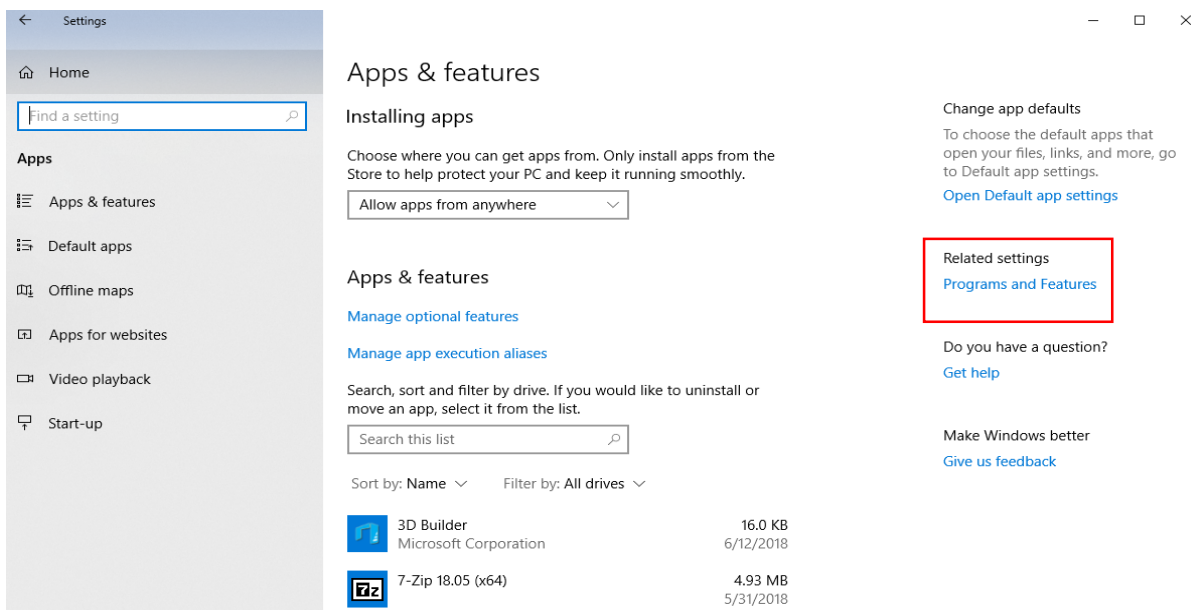
## How to enable SMB1 from Windows 10

Since Windows 10 Sept. 2017 update, SMB1 is disabled, here is a guide explaining how to enable it. As VBox files system for managing external files such as recordings or XML TV stored on NAS or a computer library works with SMB1, it is necessary to enable it

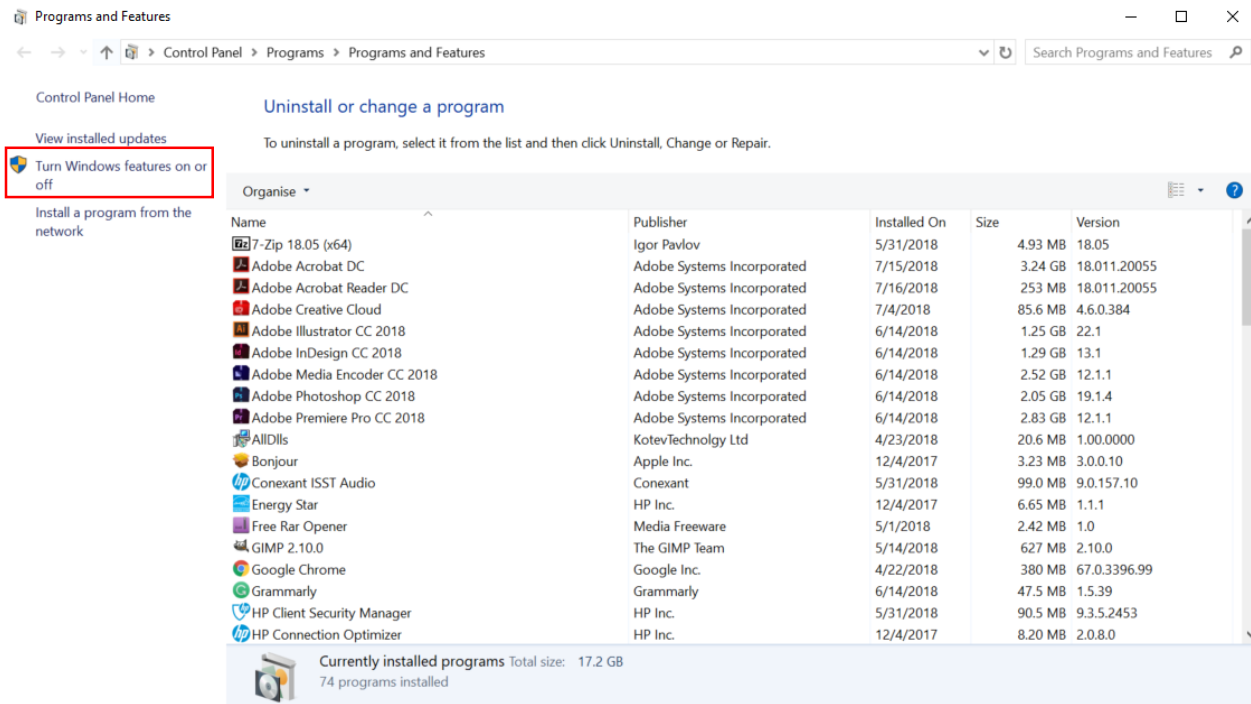
### Step 1: Go to Windows settings and select Apps



### Step 2: Select Programs and Features



**Step 3: Select Turn Windows features on or off**



**Step 4: Scroll down to SMB 1.0/CIFS File Sharing Support, tick its box, expand it and tick all applicable boxes, SMB 1.0/CIFS Client and SMB 1.0/CIFS Server, and then press OK.**

**\*Please note that in order for the setting to become effective you will need to restart your computer\***
